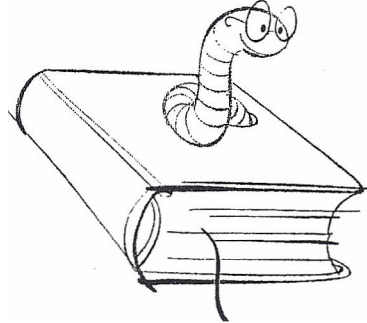


Available at the Lewiston Public Library
